

10 ways to celebrate queer youth in your faith community



1. Panel Discussion

Host a panel discussion with members of the faith community, including LGBTQ+ individuals, clergy, and allies. Topics can include acceptance, inclusion, and creating affirming spaces for queer youth in faith communities.

2. Share a Pride-themed Sermon



Invite faith leaders to share sermons with their congregations that uplift and empower queer people, especially youth.



3. LGBTQ+ Testimonies

Invite queer youth to share their testimony with their congregation on their experience as a queer person and a person of faith. Invite them to share their queer faith journey.



4. Affirming Prayers

Invite congregations to pray for the lives of queer people. These prayers should provide love, acceptance, and gratitude over the lives of queer people.

5. Talent Showcase

Host a talent showcase where queer youth can display their talents and passions. Whether it's singing, dancing, poetry, or storytelling, provide a platform for them to express themselves authentically.



6. Affirmation Cards

Invite congregations to create personalized cards filled with affirmation that can then be given to queer congregants.

7. Dance Party

Invite congregants to host a in-person dance party, where congregants can connect with other queer people and allies in a fun way.





8. Faith-Based Allyship Training

Offer allyship training workshops for members of the faith community who want to learn how to be better allies to LGBTQ+ individuals. Cover topics like active listening, inclusive language, and supporting LGBTQ+ youth.

9. Inclusive Faith Study Groups



Organize inclusive faith study groups that explore LGBTQ+ affirming interpretations of scriptures and religious teachings. Encourage open dialogue and critical reflection on traditional interpretations.



10. Faith Healing Circle

Host a healing circle or virtual gathering where LGBTQ+ individuals come together to share stories of resilience, healing journeys, and strategies for spiritual well-being. Incorporate elements like guided meditation, affirmations, and communal blessings.
